62 responses from full term programme leavers between 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020 and 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020

**95%**  
positive progression

PROGRESSION

95% of learner had a positive progression at the end of their apprenticeship

**81%**  
in full time employment

FULL TIME EMPLOYMENT

81% were in full time employment after their apprenticeship

**8%**  
another apprenticeship

ANOTHER APPRENTICESHIP

8% progressed to another apprenticeship

**64%**  
in a more senior role

MORE SENIOR ROLE

64% were in a more senior role by the end of their apprenticeship

**83%**  
still with employer

STILL WITH EMPLOYER

83% were still with their apprenticeship employer

**61%**  
progression opportunities

OPPORTUNITIES

61% received opportunities for progression with their employer while on their apprenticeship

**69%**  
promoted

PROMOTED

69% were promoted or given extra responsibilities while on their apprenticeship

**45%**  
salary increased

SALARY INCREASE

45% said their salary increased intermittently while on their apprenticeship

earning more
